Children in The Babies Room have been enjoying lots of Sensory Play, after Lambs staff went on Treasure Basket Training. The staff in Little Lambs Room have been to visit another Fisherfield setting who have introduced a quiet sensory time each day for the babies.



The children have now started doing this themselves, Sensory Play allows babies to learn about their world through exploring their 5 senses; hearing, sight, smell, touch & taste and hands-on activities help to stimulate these senses. This is a great way for children to explore the world we live in and offers valuable one to one time with their key persons and staff.

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'School Readiness' Topic


