The Farmers had a special treat this month when they had a visit from Lama Ahbay Rinpoche. When he was only 12 years old, His Holiness the Dalai Lama identified him as the reincarnation of the hermit Lama Lobsang Tenzin, who lived in a

cave and was famous for his supernatural powers.

The Farmers asked him lots of questions about his life including "where do you live?" and "do you play with toys like us?"

Ahbay taught us that it's important to play even when you are a grown up, as this will keep you happy forever. The children made him a card with lots of orange (his favourite colour) and we gave him some flowers and chocolates which we know he liked!

Later we looked on the computer to see pictures of his home in India and to research about what foods they eat there and what language they speak. When they saw the monastery one of the Farmers said "wow it's like a princess's castle!"
