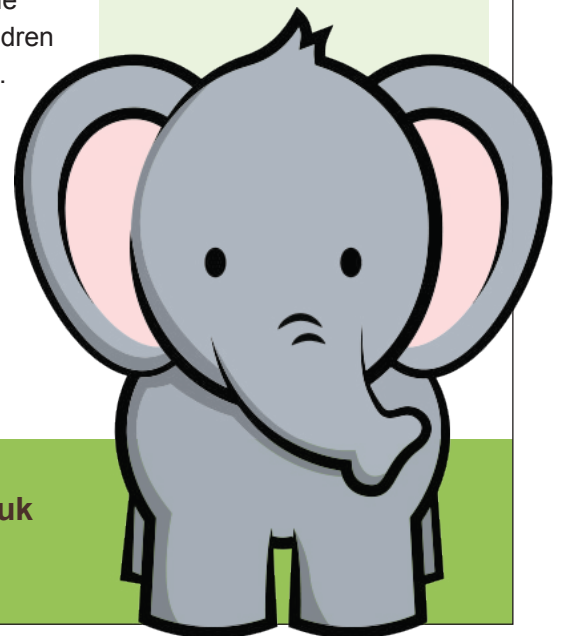
General news

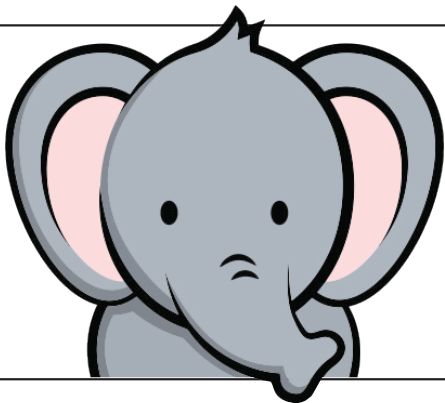

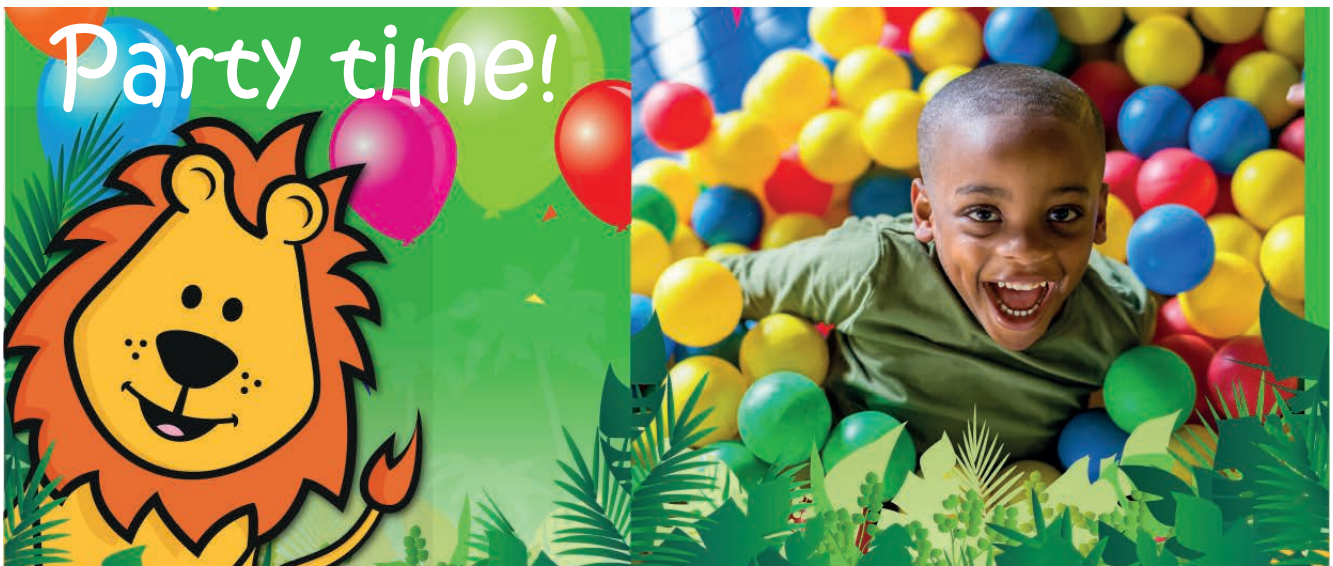
