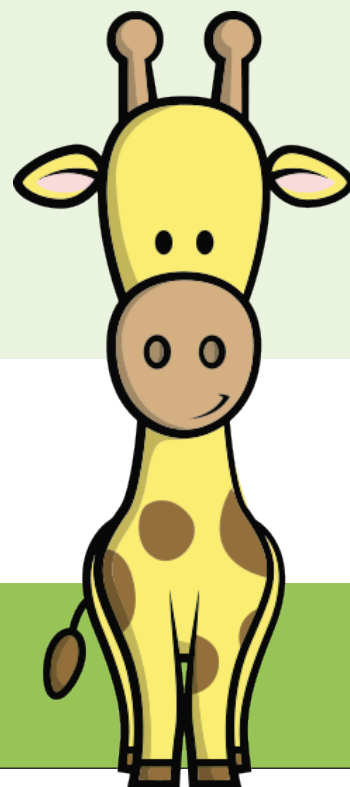

“Do you know what the Literacy Project is?”

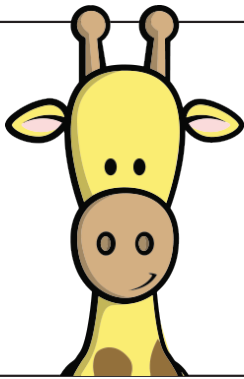
