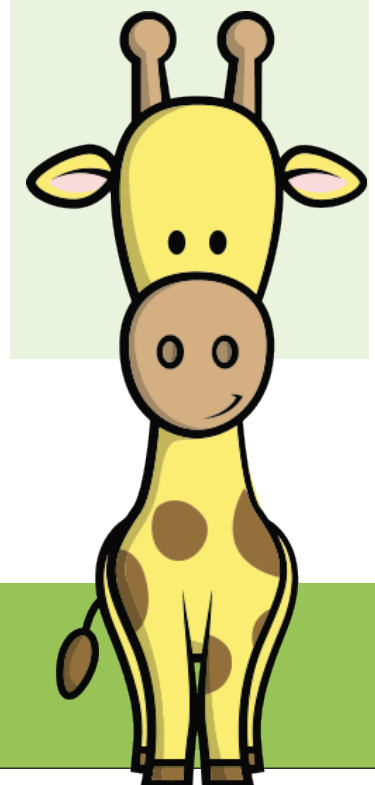


Little Farmers

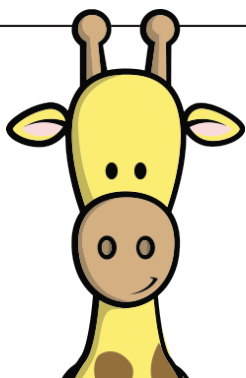
August:
