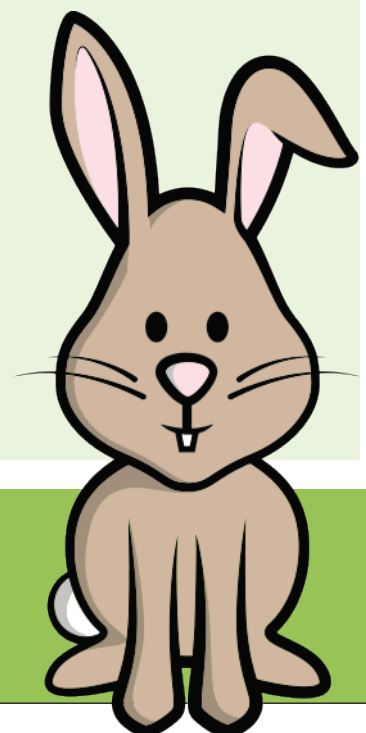

Norden Carnival

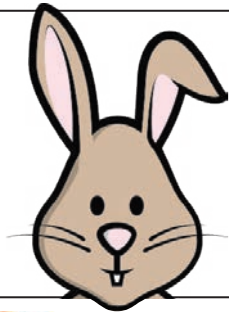
The Fisherfield team had a great time representing Fisherfield at the Norden Carnival in Rochdale. We won a prize for Best Dressed Float!
