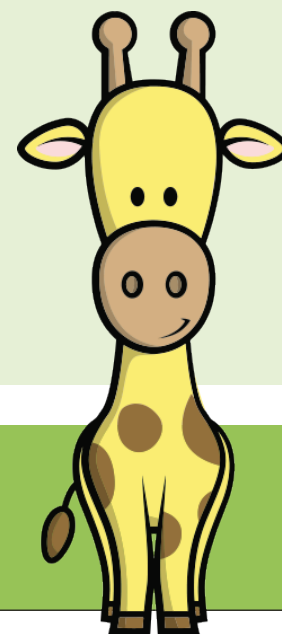

The Farmers have enjoyed taking part in Portuguese classes with Susana, learning simple words including: names of fruits that we enjoy and day to day objects within the room.

We have been incorporating the use of yoga and mindfulness into our daily routine including encouraging children to discuss one thing that they are grateful for and also focusing on stretching and breathing techniques.
