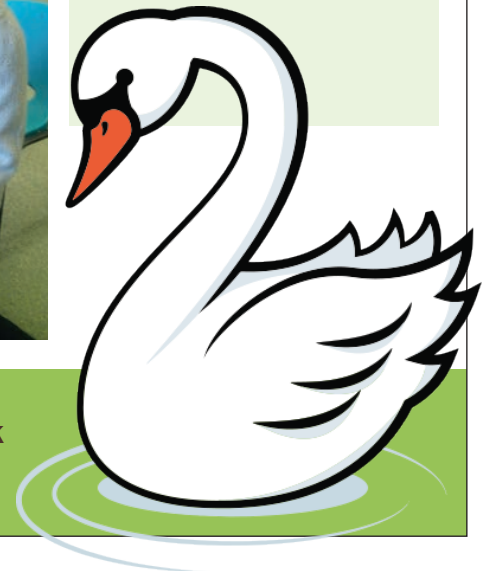


Ducks
