Through Forest School activities, the Lambs have been exploring different environmental sounds. This has supported children to understand and co-operate with boundaries whilst identifying and imitating different sounds such as cars, planes, trains and birds.

The Lambs children have loved reading the story 'Don't Call me Sweet'. The children have taken part in activities linking to the story such as making monster masks, baking swamp cakes, taking part in an ogre hunt and using messy play to make bug eyed stew.

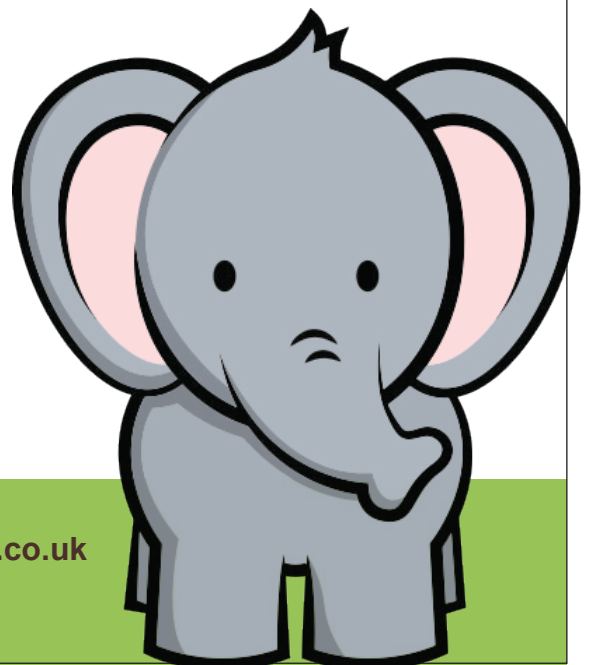


Ducklings

The Ducklings have been taking part in feelings activities during key worker time both Laura and Olivia. They have made personal key group boxes which include photographs of the children, emotion cards and the golden rules. By using these boxes daily, the children have been exploring their own feelings and understanding their own needs. The children have also been understanding boundaries and how to follow daily routines.

The Ducklings have introduced mindfulness into the 5-minute physicals carried out each week. Through our mindfulness sessions the children have explored how to build resilience, regulate emotions and focus their attention.

The Ducklings have also been learning about how to care for the environment through Forest School activities. The children have been introduced to a new story about recycling and went around the nursery to find recyclable resources.
