

#### **Little Farmers**

The Farmers have gained a new friend at nursery - 'Vlad' the skeleton! They have really enjoyed learning all about the human body, including the skeleton and organs, learning some new and interesting bone names. To develop this further we joined in with a skeleton dance and listened to the 'Funny Bones' stories.

The Farmers have enjoyed taking part in a new Proprioception activity, where we have focused more on horizontal body movements including 'pushing' and 'pulling'. This allows children muscles to stretch and be stimulated and encourages the children to work together by developing their peer relationships. Our nursery Proprioception activities have also been shared with our other Fisherfield nurseries; we will also be sharing more information with parents at our first Proprioception Session on Wednesday 4th March at 2:30pm. Further information will be provided nearer to the time.

Thank you to all parents who have joined in with our 'Secret Reader' and have been into nursery to read to our children.
