Lambs

The Lambs team have been working to support children's acquisition of language following training they received on the annual Fisherfield Childcare Training Day in January. The Lambs team amended their 'Word of the Week' to 'Word of the Day' to celebrate the language children develop each day. From this, the staff team have seen a big growth in the language the children are using and also from how they learn from one another. The children are repeating more words and the staff are using these opportunities to take the children on exciting, child-led learning journeys throughout the day. For example, during snack the children were exploring a tangerine before it was peeled. They discovered it could roll and Unna said the word "roll." Following this, the staff planned activities where the children could explore this word and concept further such as ball painting.



Ducklings

In the Ducklings room, we have been focusing on mindfulness and physical activities. The children have particularly enjoyed our Yoga sessions where they have learnt to carry out poses and stretches based on animals and nature. From these activities, the children have learnt about spatial awareness and how their bodies can move in different ways. These small group sessions have also had a huge impact on the children's concentration skills and behaviour, and we look forward to developing this further.

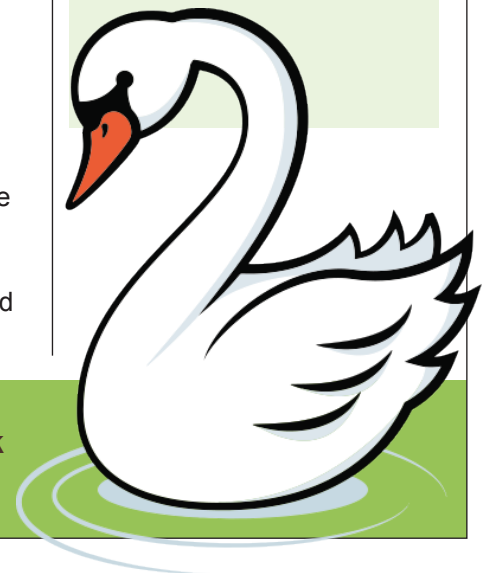

Farmers

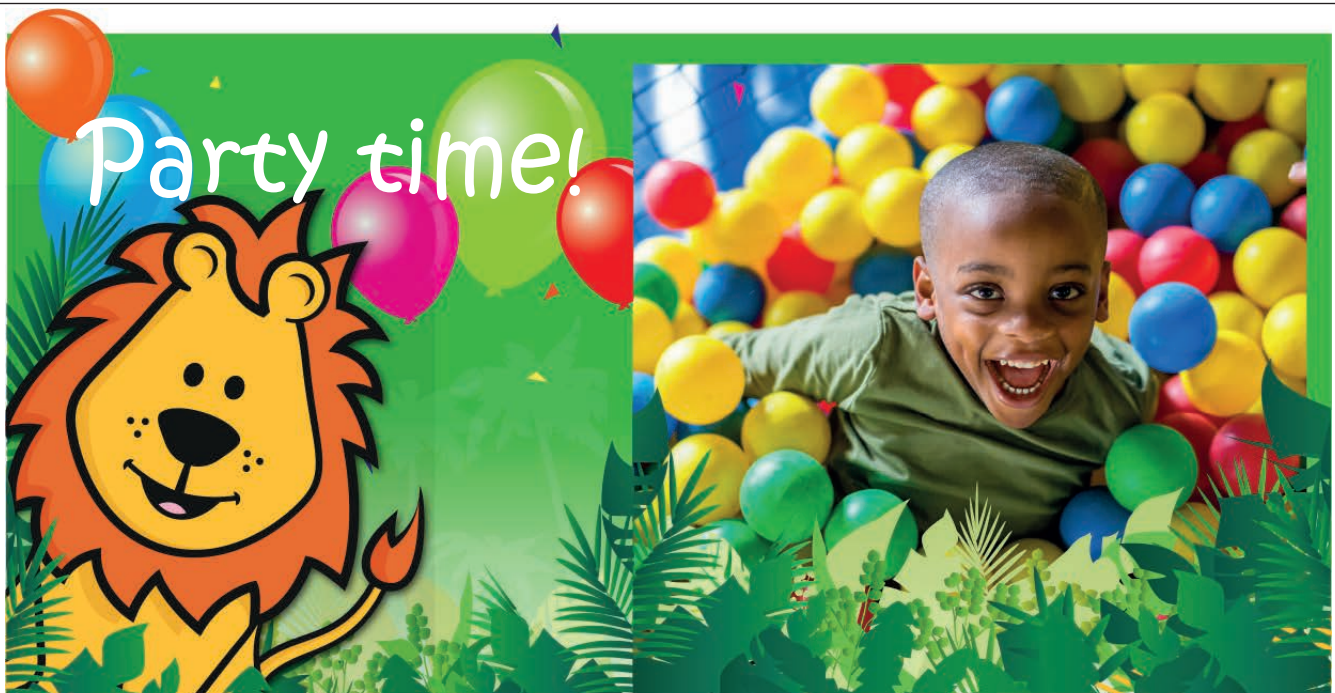
