The Lambs have all loved the challenge of measuring, mixing and of course trying the different baked goods. The Lambs are currently creating a recipe book of all the things they have created at nursery and at home so we have a permanent memento of these experiences. Lambs have also created keyworker bags that are displayed in the room. The children use these with staff at group times and have really enjoyed discovering what is inside them.

The children enjoyed dressing up and creating role play scenarios together. We also discovered a book named 'Supertato'. This then led us on to a topic about food and the Farmers were particularly interested in learning about how food grows. We have learnt lots of new vocabulary and concepts by looking at different foods, planting seeds, digging up vegetables and even making our own root veg soup... Yummy!

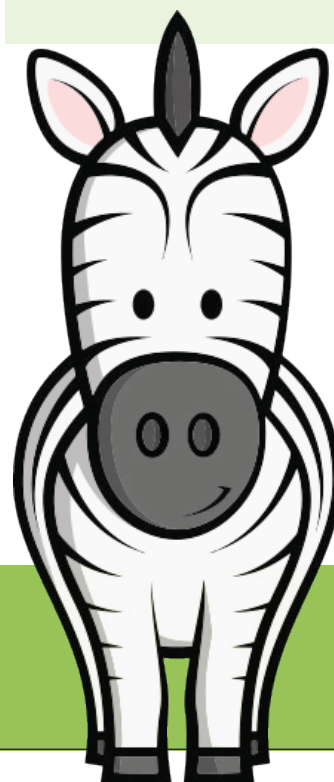

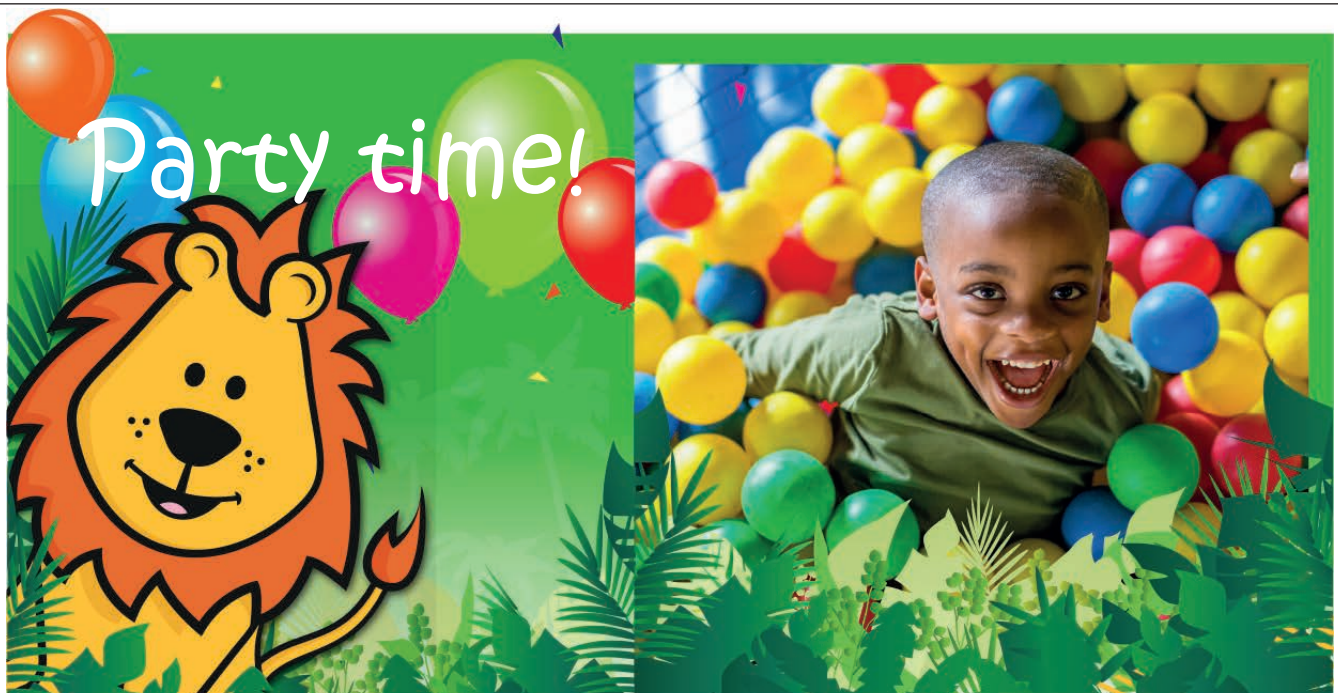
