Both rooms have created their christmas lists for santa and we have had a special visitor this past month – Ellie the elf who has been causing mischief and playing pranks!

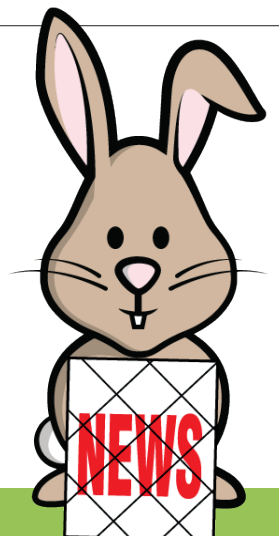

Over the next couple of months we will be focussing on forest school activities, exploring the outdoors and looking at any changes that may have happened over christmas break. In the farmers room they will be focusing on independence, so each day they will choose children to be helper for the day and they will be starting to focus on school readiness, looking at activities to help the children get ready for school in September, this will include circle time activities. In the Lambs and Ducks we will be focusing on sensory play and with the older children encouraging independence for example trying to put our own coats on.
