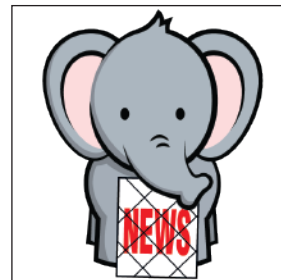

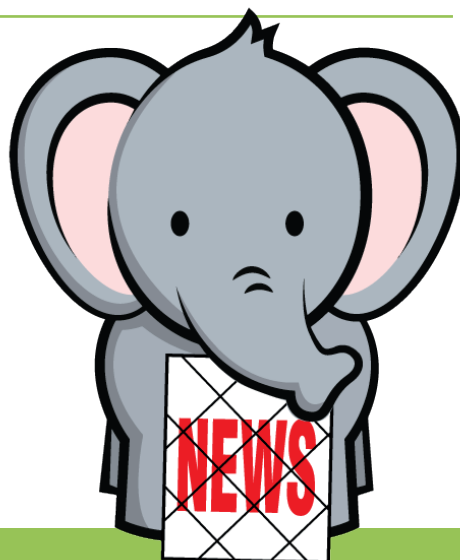
**Monday 14th - VALENTINES BALL**
