LOOK WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING.

The lambs and Ducklings have shown an interest in the farm animals, to extend this further we have been reading "Oh Dear" in which the children have been able to identify the animal by name or by sound. To continue our learning journey, we have been looking and talking about vegetables including carrots and potatoes and where they come from, we have used these for carrot painting and made a vegetable patch. The children have also enjoyed using the food box pictures to extend their learning while playing in the home corner.

The farmers children have enjoyed the introduction of our mini me's to our small world area. Each child has their own mini version of themselves, which has allowed them to begin learning about similarities and different between themselves and their friends. We have been finding out how many children have blue and brown eyes or blond hair, counting them up and seeing who has the most. The children have also enjoyed using their characters to extend their play in the dolls house.

In the Explorers the children have been taking parts in lots of activities to promote independence such as attempting to tie their own shoelaces and zipping up their own coats. The children have spent time learning what will be expected of them when they transition to school, looking at what their school uniform will look like and the structure of the school day.
