

# LOOK WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING

The children have been really engaged in the Gruffalo story. The Lambs ducklings have been looking at different animals that we find in the forest and using natural resources to build them ourselves. We went on bug hunts and created our own bug hand prints. We made Gruffalo crumble and worm soup for tea. We also created dens for the children to understand where the different animals in the story live. To celebrate Superhero week we have enjoyed playing superhero physical games outdoors including silly power races, role playing special missions and making our own superhero costumes. The children spoke about what superhero power they would like to have and why. We then made our own superhero base using the parachute outside where the children all gathered to have a party when they saved the day! The Farmers children have also been learning about the changing season, learnt about the flowers that spring and how we grow and take care of them. We have made our own sunflower plants and have been observing them grow over the weeks. Children have taken their plants home and planted them in their gardens and are measuring the height of the sunflowers every weekend.

We will be focusing this next topic on creating our new fairy garden where we will be growing our own fruit and vegetables for the fairy's. We will also be learning about the growth of our sunflowers and planting different flowers in our greenhouse.
