In the little lamb's room the main focus has been supporting the children's physical development as many of them are beginning to achieve a massive milestone by taking their first steps! In the garden the lambs have enjoyed using the baby walkers to help them explore the outdoors and we have created sensory paths with sand and water for the children to walk through.

In the Duckling's room the children have enjoyed planting sunflowers and learning how to look after our environment. This month the children have completely transformed the flower beds by planting wildflower seeds. Each day we have enjoyed watching the stems shoot up and change into different colours and sizes. In Duckling's we have also focused on our sensory play and have enjoyed bringing lots of creative and water play activities outside, a firm favourite was creating "lemonade" in our water tray with fresh lemon slices and jugs/containers.

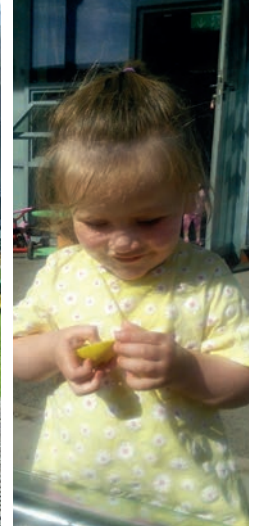
