LOOK WHAT WE HAVE DONE ..

We have celebrating lots of exciting fun filled occasions this month at nursery. We was fortunate to be able to invite a special visitor to nursery an old staff member Riffhat who very kindly came and did Henna on our children and parents when we celebrated Eid! We all loved this and most staff, children and some parents got involved. We made samosas, dressed up, made cards and did lots of dancing.

We have also celebrated World bee day, we all dressed in yellow and black, went on a bee hunt and a very friendly bee was lucky enough to land for all the children to admire. We painted pictures, tasted honey and learnt facts about different kinds of bee species. The children loved designing their own wings and having facepaint on. We had such a buzzeeee day!

In Farmers the past month we have been focussing on outdoor play and exploring the woodlands in more depth. We have been learning about birds and insects and have been on a bird scavenger! We made our own binoculars from card and camouflaged them with feathers and then explored the outdoor area over a few days ticking off any birds we found. Alongside learning about birds we have been finding some different bugs in our magnifying containers, we have found a pregnant spider carring a sac, millipedes and a huge daddy long legs. The children have been able to get close with the insect's looking through the magnyifying glasses and have been learning new vacubalary to describe what they can see. Alongside our bug and animal focus we have been learning new sign language gestures such as bee, bear and worm!

In ducks room we have been focussing on our routine, circle time activities and learning all about our friends in our room. We have introduced new songs and dances to help learn friends names and a friendship ring we use at circle times to help children recognise the routine and sit in a circle. We have been painting friends portraits, doing mirror play activities and have started a dinner time helper who now helps give out all the cups, plates and cutlery getting them ready for the transition to farmers room.

In lambs the children have been learning and focussing on new single words each month like thankyou, please and its currently Lion linking to their book of the month 'Dear Zoo'. The children have shown an increase of interest in books recently so Becky and Gemma have been using different types of picture, interactive and simple worded books alongside puppets to follow their curiosity. We have also been focussing on our families and in lambs have created family trees on canvases around the room using the children hand and foot prints and adding family photos on for the children to look at. We have all been getting ready to celebrate our Queens jubilee creating flags, cards and crowns for our party and exploring different colours on our light board!



During June month we will be continuing to follow the childrens interest's in topics throughout all rooms and focus on farmers children transitioning to school with more school readiness activities.
