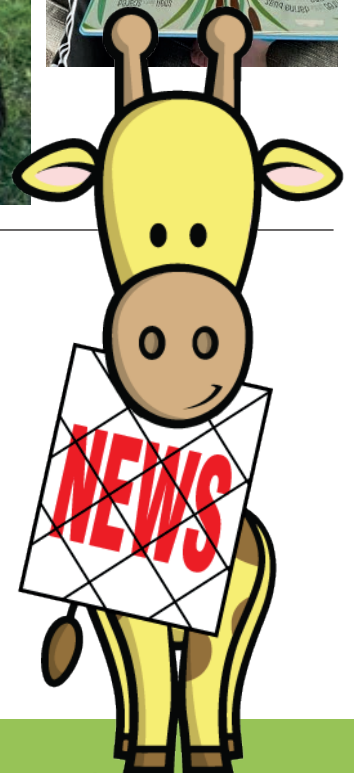
BAGSLATE BIRD-WATCHERS!
