LOOK WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING.

The Lambs have really enjoyed making their own flapjacks using their own bowls and spoons to independently mix the ingredients together and also to support their fine motor skills. This activity linked into our song of the week "When Goldilocks went to the house of the bears". To extend their learning we will be completing activities to support their fine motor skills further.

In Ducklings we have been focusing on developing our math's skills through carrying out weekly baking sessions to help the children compare amounts, count in sequence, understand simple shapes and use senses to explore different ingredients used. To extend this further we will be focusing our next case study around basic shapes.

The Farmers have taken part in forest school activities including making clay snail models after going on a snail hunt. We have also been den building and listening to natural sounds whilst taking part in mindfulness activities.







Explorers have been learning about different emotions. They have enjoyed reading the series of books 'The colour monster', where they have been exploring their emotions and discussing their worries. They made a 'Worry Rocket' and made pictures of the things they was worried about, we pinned them to the rocket and launched it into space taking their worries with it.
