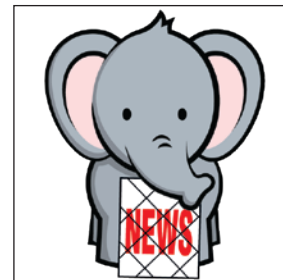

Friday 23rd Sept – INTERNATIONAL DAY OF SIGN LANGUAGE

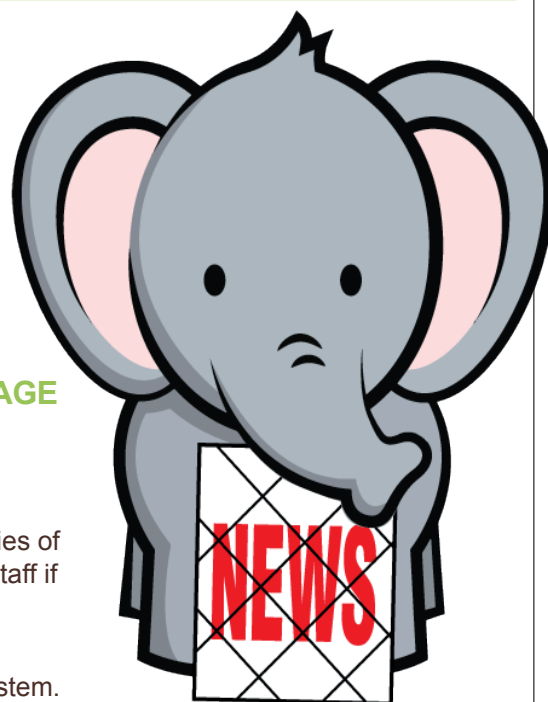
We will be teaching the children different key words and nursery rhymes in sign language.
