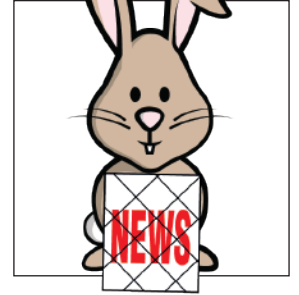

In our Lambs room the children carried out a forest school week where they baked, had sensory play and had smores around their campfire roleplay.

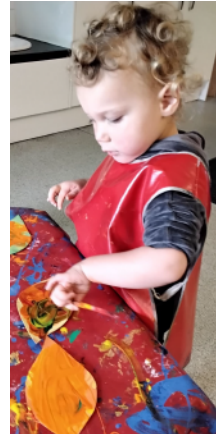
In the Ducks room they have been carrying out lots of forest school creative activities, making collages and conker rolling in paint.
