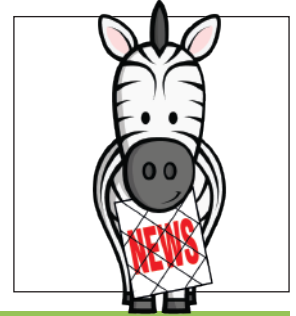

25TH OCTOBER – NATIONAL ART DAY

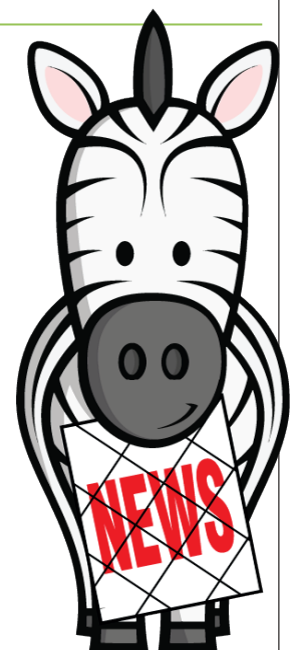
Here we will ask the children to create their own art work at home and bring it into nursery for our art competition. We will be doing lots of arts and crafts throughout the day.
