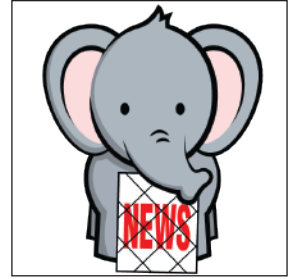

LAMBS

The little lambs have had lots of fun reading the book 'dear zoo', each week the children have learnt about a different zoo animal from the book and have taken part in activities relating to that animal. The lambs have taken part in different messy activities such as creating animal footprints during a floor painting activity, exploring spaghetti snakes and jungle boogie time during our singing session. This book has helped encourage the development of communication and language in the lamb's room as many of our children have started repeating familiar phrases from the story book.

The farmers have been taking part in science experiments as they have been making their own potions and creating mini baking soda explosions. We have also had a great response from our parents who have been invited to join our P.E and dance classes, the children had lots of fun during these sessions and has helped promote the children's physical development and fitness.

They have been exploring the different herbs by using their senses such as touch, feel and taste. The children have made herb play dough and experimented with baking by tasting and smelling different cakes when adding different herbs. The children have gone on a learning journey by learning where herbs grow and have explored their natural environment as they have taken part in forest school activities and exploring our mud station in our outdoors area.

8TH DEC - CHRISTMAS JUMPER DAY

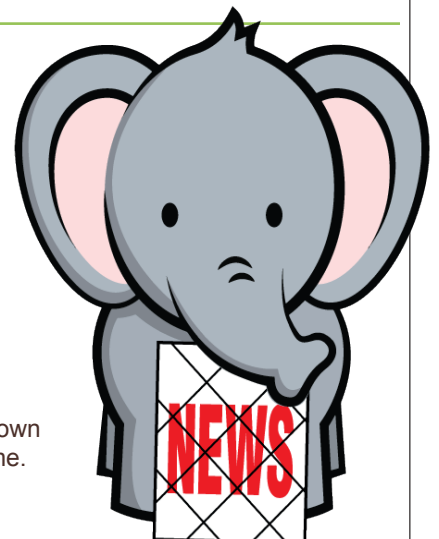
We will have a Christmas jumper day, please come in your favourite festive jumpers.
