Across the nursery we have been joining in with a variety of celebrations such as valentines day and chinese new year. The children have been learning about their emotions especially the emotion 'Love' for valentines day. Also alongside chinese new year and the usual dress up and role play opportunities the children have been able to learn about other cultures and develop a sense of identity and develop their knowlegde with understanding the world around them.

In the lambs room the children have enjoyed sensory activities and carrying out lots of baking activities developing their independence skills, as some of the older lambs have been doing visits and are ready to transition into the older room Ducks. In ducks the children have been focussing on their independence skills also developing their home corner area with a new dressing table, mirror and objects found at home to role play with such as hairdryers, bangles and brushes. The staff have been taking a step back in this area and letting the children take lead with their imagination skills and developing their vocabulary and communication skills.

In Farmers the children have been talking a lot about emotions and linking to mental health and developing friendships. They have been reading 'The colour monster' story exploring not only what emotions are but why we feel them. The children have enjoyed learning new yoga positions and songs linking to emotions during circle time sessions.
