We held a sing and rhyme session with the parents who came to join us. This was very successful, and the Ducklings children were so excited to see their family and friends participate in our nursery rhymes and dance session.

Following this the Lambs children joined in with the Ducklings and the Farmers in hosting songs and rhymes session in nursery.

We introduced different musical instruments to encourage listening and encouraged the children to identify the different sounds they could hear.
