### LAMBS

The children have enjoyed exploring the 'That's not my Bee' story. We explored different textures from the environment. We found different coloured leaves, flowers, mud, and sticks and brought them into the exploration tray inside where we spent time learning new words while we explored using all our senses.

### DUCKS

As it was the King's coronation we have been learning about different forms of transport, linked to the 'My King' story. We set up obstacle course for the cars and trucks, looked at the tyre marks different vehicles made and went plane spotting in the garden. Linking to this we have also attached a train track on the wall as the children like pushing the trains on the walls.
