

# LOOK WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING ..

We also had a great time at our nursery forest school stay and play, it was great to show the parents how we promote forest school and show off some of our activities.

In the Farmer's room we have been learning about autumn and how the environment around us has begun to change. The children also enjoyed learning our new autumn song. We spoke about the leaves changing colours and beginning to fall off the trees and we also learnt about the weather getting colder and daylight hours getting shorter. During outdoor play we noticed lots of leaves had already begun to fall from the tree. From this the children made leaf hedgehogs, we went on a leaf hunt and used glue to stick them down to make their wonderful creations.

The lambs have been using keyworker time to create keyworker boxes that consisted of objects that the children have showed interest in. The children and staff use the objects to explore using all their senses and introduce key words to the children. We have linked the objects to the 'Going on a bear hunt' book which has been our focus over the last few weeks.

The Duckling's children have been really enjoying good morning each day using Makaton alongside the sings that we sing. They have been exploring natural materials linking to the 'Leaf Man' story. We have been using our senses to feel soil, grass, sand and water and the children also enjoyed using their feet to explore these elements. The children have enjoyed listening to the leaf man story and carried out lots of fun activities based around the book and the animals he sees while being blown away by the wind.

## WHAT WE WILL BE DOING NEXT...

The staff within the Farmer's room have started their stay and play keyworker sessions and will continue with this over the next couple of months. Across the nursery we are currently developing our self-regulation area/ mindfulness area to support the children with their emotions.
