LOOK WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING...

The Lamb's and Duck's children have been focusing on the 'Dear Zoo' story, exploring different textures and materials. We have developed a story bag, with the children's work inside, to use as props as we read the story which has supported the children's engagement. The children were encouraged to access the story independently and were supported to recognise and name the animals they could see in the story.

The children in Farmer's have been learning about Diwali, we had fun exploring colours using all our senses. The children enjoyed exploring clay, to make their own Diyas for the special day. Linking to this we explored colour as it was Bonfire night, we made our own fireworks, and discussed all the sounds and colours we had seen.

Our Explorer's children have been learning about the different animals which hibernate in the winter, we looked at the different places they go to hide form the cold and the foods they eat and store for later. The children enjoyed making their own hibernating houses, using natural materials and junk modelling.
