LOOK WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING...

The Lamb's children have enjoyed exploring different textures linking to Halloween, through the 'Very Hungry Caterpillar', trick or treat story. The children enjoyed exploring a pumpkin, they explored the outside of the pumpkin first and then cut it open to touch the texture inside. The children enjoyed rolling the pumpkin as they practised their gross motor skills, painting it using different tools.

The Duckling's children have enjoyed going on a bear hunt, practising the different sounds from the story as they explored the different materials and texture from the story such as mud and snow. The children enjoyed looking for the bear, while exploring outside. We have also spent lots of time bug hunting in our Halloween tuff trays with the pumpkins and spider webs.

The Farmers have enjoyed the 'Colour Monster' book, linking the different colours in the story to our emotions. The children enjoyed making their own monsters in playdough and with paint, talking about how they feel, what and who makes them feel happy.
