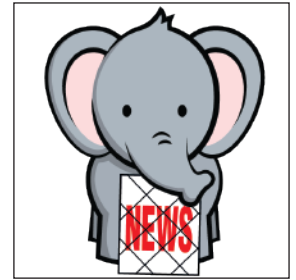

## LOOK WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING...

The Farmer's children have recently been very creative and have been taking on a more independent role in their play and exploration. They have been choosing their own 'book with a hook' and helping to plan activities around the book and their own interests. The children have taken part in junk modelling activities and looking at the different uses of items that would usually go in the bin. To further enhance this exploration, we will be exploring a recycling book (wc. 18/03/24-global recycling day) teaching the children how to recycle household items and the impact recycling has on the environment. The Farmer's children have also been taking part in mathematics activities to enhance their mathematics development. We have taken part in number hunts, number tracing, colour mixing in the water, number songs and rhymes.

The Ducklings and Lambs have been very active recently! Everyday we have taken part in different physical activity, such as dancing every day to funky feet, taking part in animal yoga, taking part in playdough disco, and running around outside exploring all weathers. The children also had lots of fun during our Mother's Day tea party stay and play, which involved lots of yummy snacks and treats as well as lots of playing!
