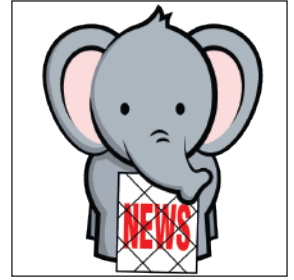

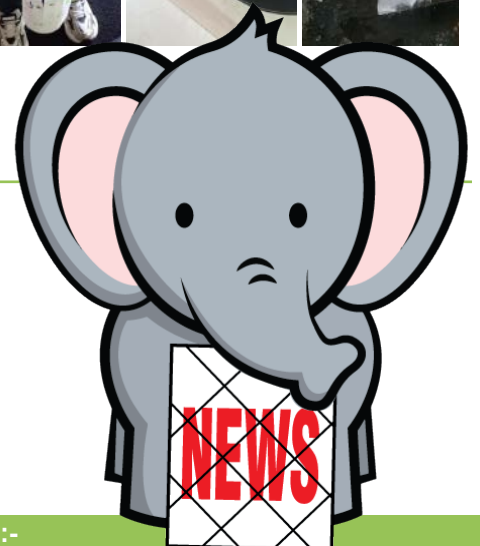
### LOOK WHAT WE WILL BE DOING NEXT...
