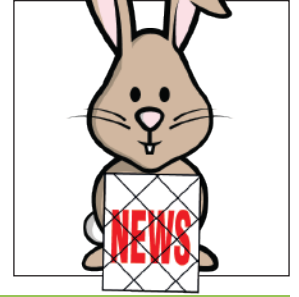

Across the nursery we have been learning about lots of different topics such as life cycles, caring for our planet and animal habitats.
