#### **LAMBS**

The children have enjoyed taking part in lots of fun crafts and sensory activities linked to Easter. The children also created their own caterpillars using junk modelling, decorating them with a variety of colours and materials. They had lots of fun during caterpillar PE, moving in different ways just like a caterpillar.



In the Farmer's room, the children have had a fantastic time celebrating Easter. They participated in lots of physical activities, including egg and spoon races, a fun Easter egg hunt left by the Easter Bunny, and making a range of Easter crafts to take home.

#### **EXPLORERS**

The Explorers have been learning about the life cycle of our nursery caterpillars, linked to the book of the week, *The Amazing Life Cycle of Butterflies*. The children enjoyed watching the caterpillars build their cocoons and are excited to see if they have transformed into butterflies.
