WHAT HAVE WE BEEN DOING...

What a sunny month of May we've had! Across the nursery, we have loved spending so much time outdoors, enjoying the sunshine and bringing lots of our indoor activities out into the garden.

In the Little Lambs room, the children have been exploring a variety of sensory and heuristic play. A brand-new black and white area has been introduced in both the main room and the sensory room. These areas are especially helpful for supporting each child's concentration and attention span. We've filled them with soft cushions, sensory books, soft toys, puzzles, and blocks – and the children have really enjoyed the calm and engaging space. Over in the Ducklings room, many of our children have started their toilet training journeys, which has made for a very exciting and important month.

We've been talking lots about self-care and hygiene, including why sun cream is important, how to wash our hands properly, and remembering to brush our teeth. One of the highlights of the month was our spa day! The children have also spent plenty of time outdoors focusing on physical development – from weeding the flower beds and creating obstacle courses to going on bug hunts and splashing in water play.

In Farmers, many of the children are preparing for their next big step – starting school in September! We've been focusing on school readiness by encouraging independence and helping children learn how to manage their emotions. We'd like to say a huge thank you to everyone who attended our parent workshops and pre-school parents evening. We're so grateful for your involvement and support.
