

LOOK WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING...

Thank you to everyone who attended Parents' Evening—it was lovely to see you all and have the opportunity to speak with everyone individually.

Across the nursery, the children really engaged in World Bee Day. It was wonderful to see them all taking part, dressed as little bumblebees and in yellow and black to celebrate. We learnt so many interesting facts about bees and used these throughout the day during various activities. The children even got to try some real honey after learning how bees make it—it was delicious!

Little Lambs have been enjoying books about animals, showing a particular interest in That's Not My Lion. The children took part in lots of sensory activities relating to animals, including animal stomping in paint, creating a big jungle scene where animals were hiding, making nature pictures, reading stories, and singing songs. The Lambs have done brilliantly repeating the names of animals and the sounds they make. We've also made the most of the sunny weather with plenty of ice and water play outdoors.

Ducklings have been showing a real interest in the story of The Three Little Pigs. The children have been re-enacting the story both indoors and outdoors and used story maps around the garden. We had lots of fun making the pigs' houses, using our senses to explore the different materials. The children were excited to build a large den outside to hide from the Big Bad Wolf, using fabrics and materials to create their very own house.

Farmers have been exploring the story of Supertato as part of their focus on healthy eating. They've also been learning about 3D shapes, which the children have shown great interest in. Using connecting pipes, crates, and drainpipes, the children worked together to build different 3D shapes. We are also in the process of creating a magical enchanted forest story area amongst the trees, as storytime outdoors has become a big favourite with the Farmers.
