


DORSET DRIVE

Wow – what a busy couple of months we've had at nursery! We said goodbye to many of our friends who are moving on to Primary School and celebrated with a series of special activity days, including Games Day, Art Attack Day (where we loved getting extremely messy!), Graduation, and our Superhero and Princess themed pre-school party. The children thoroughly enjoyed every minute, and we wish them all the very best of luck in their next chapter.

The whole site has also been working hard together to look after our allotment. Over the past few months, we have planted different seeds and carefully cared for them by watering, removing insects, and helping them grow. We are proud to say we've successfully grown a variety of vegetables and fruits such as courgettes, potatoes, strawberries, apples, lettuce, and pea pods. The children have enjoyed using these in the home corner role play and trying the fresh produce at snack times.

In the rooms, the children have been busy exploring lots of exciting topics:

FARMERS have been learning about safety in the home, road safety, and stranger danger. They also explored the theme of real-life superheroes such as doctors, paramedics, carers, and police. This led to discussions about what the children would like to be when they grow up, giving them a fantastic understanding of different occupations and their role in the community.

DUCKS have been learning about colours through stories such as Colour Rainbow and The Colour Monster. They have enjoyed dressing up days, colour mixing, and creative activities including making hot air balloons, exploring foam, and engaging in a variety of sensory trays.

LAMBS have been learning all about under the sea and sea creatures, inspired by their interest in animal stories. They created their own sea pictures using different materials, learned new songs and words each day, and took part in large-scale mark making with their hands, feet, and whole bodies.

Looking ahead, we are excited to welcome lots of new families and children into our setting. The children will be supporting their new friends to settle in and get to know our nursery routines. We are also looking forward to restarting our Forest School sessions in the woodland area, where we'll be going on bug hunts, making bunting to decorate the trees, and enjoying role play campfires and story times.
