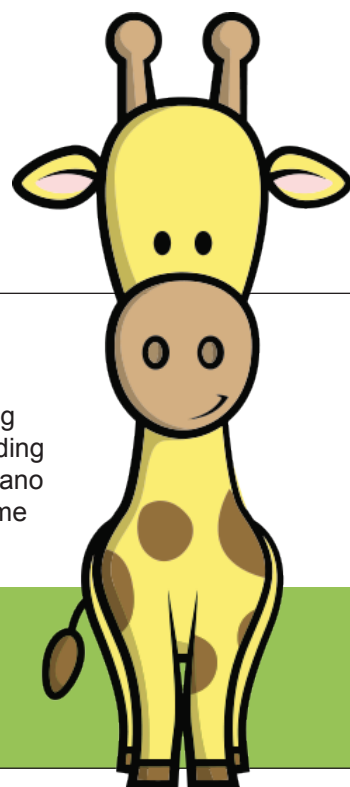
Badger and the Great Storm
