Settling into Nursery/Family Photos



We would all like to give all our parent/carers a huge welcome to Fisherfield Childcare, Edinburgh Way. September is a busy month with many children joining us for the first time and settling in can take some time. However, the children will soon build relationships with their key person at the setting.

The staff within the nursery recently attended training in order to develop the way we support children to settle into nursery and form attachments. Following this each room has introduced a family box where the children can access pictures of their own family during the day. *Please bring in photographs of your family member for your child's box, thank you.*



Here are just a few things you can do to help:



Bring something from home to support your child in feeling reassured, such as a comforter (blanket, teddy, familiar story book from home). Ensure you have shared everything you possibly can with a staff member on a daily basis throughout the settling in sessions and induction period – small changes at home can make a significant difference to how your child feels. Lastly, be honest and consistent with your child. Preparing your child in coming to nursery is a positive thing and reassuring them that you will be back after lunch/tea will help their confidence and understanding. Also, regular attendance, routine and drop off/collection times will support your child in getting used to their new nursery day.
