## **Lambs**

Lambs have been developing their children's personal boxes, as we asked parents to provide photograph from home, and personal objects for the children.



These have been a great addition to the Lambs room, the children have enjoyed sharing their photographs with each other and displaying them around the room. If you haven't done so already please send in your child's photographs.

This gives the children a great sense of belonging and encourages discussions about home and their experiences.

Lambs have been enjoying lots of different edible sensory play in their room. They created it themselves

alongside a staff member, with edible playdough, paint and animal scenes. The children have enjoyed different smells, textures and tastes and have had great fun!

## **Ducklings**

In Ducklings the staff are looking at developing keyperson boxes to share with their children in small groups at circle time. Please can we ask that your child brings in something personal to them, for example; a small toy, storybook, or some photographs.

Greg has arranged a second visit to nursery where he will be bringing equipment for the children to take their own finger prints and other exciting activities!

This has given the children a great sense of their local community and people who help us, and the parents have reported the children have not stopped talking about Greg!

Following our police visit the children asked if they could meet a fire officer, so the staff worked hard to get in touch with the local fire brigade and see if they could visit nursery. We were very lucky that 4 firemen came to visit in a fire engine.

We even got to dress Leanne up in their uniform!
